2023 Parade Rules & Regulations – Entry & Float Guidelines

Date & Time: Saturday, November 25th at 10 am.

Parade Lineup & Location: Begins at 9 am. You must be in line no later than 9:30 am. Turn on Vann Street and you will be directed to your parade position on Terrace Lane by a committee member. **Do not be late!**

Floats/Entries MUST BE DECORATED. Decorations can include: balloons, streamers, flags, bunting, flowers, fringe, tassels and other materials. Decorations must be appropriate for public display. All floats and entries **MUST** have a **Christmas theme**.

Float Definition: A decorated platform pulled behind a motorized vehicle or machinery such as a truck, car, tractor, or etc.

Bands: All bands **MUST** play **Christmas** music throughout the parade route. All band performances **MUST** be appropriate for **ALL** ages.

Music: Only Christmas music allowed!!!!

Candy can be thrown during the parade. Please throw the candy at the feet of the recipient and not at the faces. Remember safety during the parade is our priority.

Motorcycle Clubs: NO BURNOUTS ALLOWED. You must be in control of your motorcycle at all times. All motorcycles are required to be decorated (see Floats/Entries above).

Adult Supervision: Children age 12 and under must be accompanied and supervised by an adult on all Floats/Entries.

Drivers (Vehicles/ATVs): Drivers of any and all vehicles in the parade areas must possess a valid driver's license, be at least 18 years old, and possess all liability vehicle insurance. ATV's driven in the parade by persons under 18 years of age must have a member of the group riding 18 years of age or older.

No Alcoholic Beverages: Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle, or on the person of any participant. Participants consuming alcohol prior to or during the parade will be removed from the lineup. All city, county and NC State statutes concerning the consumption of alcoholic beverages will be strictly enforced by the police before, during and after the parade.

Parade Positions: Parade positions are assigned at the discretion of the Parade Committee.

Judges: Decisions of the judges are final. Results of winning floats and bands will be contacted by phone on Monday following the parade.
